Peaceful Paths provides a wide range of free and confidential programs including an emergency services Campus with shelter and supportive housing, crisis helpline, counseling and support groups for adults, teens, and children, victim advocacy, Economic Empowerment Programs, Legal services, professional education and training, violence prevention education, and community awareness.

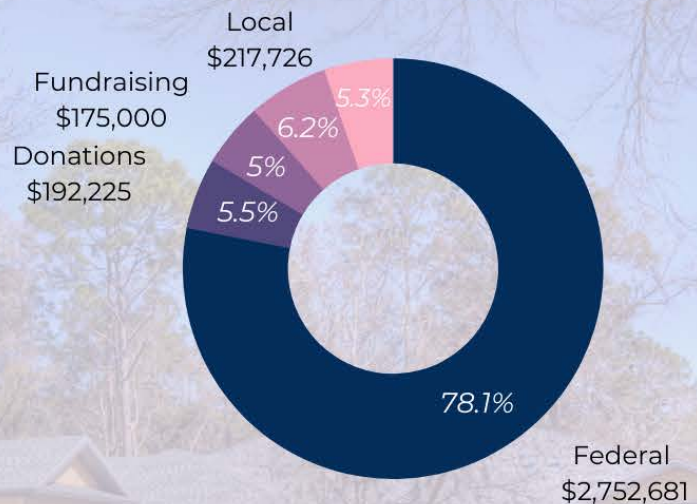

## 2021 Accomplishments & Budget

- Fundraising and Donations reached an all-time record level in 2021 with a total of **\$492,794 or 17% of the total budget.**
- Direct Client assistance exceeded a **quarter of a million dollars** for the first time ever.
- Child and Youth programming created online programming that can **reach entire grade levels simultaneously.**
- The agency provided more sessions of Trauma Therapy than ever before with **1,023 sessions to 179 survivors, including 20 children.**
- Financial Stability goals were reached with the sale of the vacant land next to the Campus, finalizing 9 years in planning and **adding \$450,000 to the agency's reserve.**
- Social Media and Awareness programs had contact with **over 180,000 people** in our tri-county region.
- Legal services reached new record levels, and created safety for hundreds of survivors with access to **free injunction support and legal advice and referrals.**
